3 DAY Cape Leveque & Return \$1,080

July 4-6, August 2-4, August 31-September 2, September 30-October 2 (Four 3 day tours only)

DAY 1 Travel from Broome to Beagle Bay and the first photographic tuition at the Sacred Heart Church with its unique pearl shell altar. After lunch and settling into your accommodation at Lombodina we are off to Cape Leveque to photograph the red cliffs at sunset. A BBQ and PowerPoint presentation finish off the day.

DAY 2 Cape Leveque for sunrise, this time at East Beach at Kooljaman Resort. After breakfast, we visit One Arm Point and their Aquaculture Centre with its stunning views of Sunday Island. Following lunch, some free time to explore Lombodina and then to their private beach for sunset and the "Staircase to the Moon".

DAY 3 After breakfast, a gentle guided canoe tour of one of the nearby tidal creeks with a local Bardi man. We paddle to a sheltered reef at the seaward end of the creek at low tide for an amazing snorkelling experience. Then lunch, and we wind our way back to Broome. You will be returned to your accommodation around 5pm.

The itinerary is subject to change as cultural events and the weather can alter the schedule.
